Keeping schools within The Mercian Trust up and running – albeit remotely – during the coronavirus outbreak is James Fendek's top priority. He is the Trust's IT Lead, Data Protection Lead and Communications Officer and thanks to Sophos and Sophos partner Wave 9, he is able to deliver the resources the teachers and staff need while on lockdown.

In 2015 – before the schools in The Mercian Trust came together to form the Trust – each was using its own firewall, provided by the Local Authority. IT Lead James says the functionality was "limited" and decided to work with Sophos partner Wave 9 to upgrade the firewalls to Sophos UTM.

Business challenges

Back in 2015, Aldridge School - a founding member of The Mercian Trust, embarked on a firewall project with Sophos partner Wave 9. The schools within the Trust were using firewalls provided by the Local Authority, yet James believed them to be inadequate – so when the schools moved away from IT provision from the Local Authority and formed a Trust, James had the authority to choose the firewalls he believed to be the best. Wave 9 suggested Sophos UTM and Sophos RED boxes as a replacement firewall solution to be used across the Trust and James decided to go ahead, supported by nine other IT staff members working in Trust schools.

Fast forward five years and the Trust is now in the midst of the coronavirus outbreak, with the IT team managing communication from the Trust to staff and teachers. Thankfully, the Sophos solution, now known as Sophos XG is robust enough to cope with this new demand and James is pleased he made the decision to switch when he did

The technical solution

The Sophos XG firewall has been designed with schools in mind and includes features purpose-built for schools and the challenges they commonly face, such as child safety, compliance and problematic behaviour online. It provides all the visibility, security, and controls that education institutions need while making everyday management and reporting easy in an affordable package.

Business benefits

The Sophos XG firewall now protects 5,500 students and 2000+ endpoints across all six Trust schools. Management of the firewall in each of the schools is carried out remotely and Wave 9 is always available to help out with setting bespoke permissions if required.


